GENERAL CIRCULAR NO. 2 : 2015 – 16

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Greetings!

After an enjoyable summer vacation the school reopened on 1st July, 2015. Since then we have had regular classes and many curricular and co-curricular activities. The response during the parent-meet-teacher session held on Saturday, 4th July was excellent. It shows the fact that the parents try to follow up with what we are trying to achieve in the school. Only the constant interaction between the parents, teachers and the school authorities brings the desired development in your wards. Do make use of this opportunity! Now, I would like to apprise you of the forthcoming activities of the school.

Welcome to Fr. Vincent Paul, S.J.: The Xavier's family extends a warm welcome to Fr. Vincent Paul as the new Administrator of the School w.e.f. June, 2015. The former Administrator, Fr. Rakesh Toppo, S.J., has gone for his higher studies.

Senior Inter House Play Festival will be held on **16th and 17th July, 2015**. You are cordially invited for the same. Kindly come and encourage the young participants. **Junior Drama** for classes VI to VIII also will be held on 24th, 27th and 28th July, 2015 starting with Std. VIII.

Feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Society of Jesus, will be celebrated on Thursday, 30th July, 2015 during the special assembly. Kindly pray for all the Jesuits all over the world.

The second Unit Test (FA II) will begin on Monday, 3rd August and will get over on Monday, 10th August, 2015. The timetable will be announced in the class. I have noticed that a large number of students remain absent during the examinations hoping for retest later. I would like to mention here that the retest is conducted only for those students who go out of station to participate in sports activities, cultural exchange programmes and those who are seriously ill and unable to attend the examinations. In that case a medical certificate is a must. **Others will be marked ABSENT and no marks will be awarded.**

Academic Achievements: Our students have performed extremely well in academics. The CBSE results of Std. X and XII were very good. **64 students scored 90% and above** and **117 students** scored between 80 and 90% marks in aggregate. **In class X 50 students scored 10 CGPA** and **70 students** scored between 9 and 10 CGPA. The large number of students securing admissions to professional institutions like IIT, Engineering and Medical Colleges of high repute are clear indications of the academic calibre of our students.

Games & Sports: Swimming: Our swimmers have participated in the Junior/Sub-Junior State level Swimming Championship held at Jaipur in June, 2015. They bagged 31 gold, 21 silver and 18 bronze medals. Two swimmers have set new records and seven swimmers are participating in the National Level Championship to be held at Pune. Three swimmers have got cash award from Rajasthan state government: Palak Sharma Rs.4,00,000 Inderpreet Sagoo and Zubin Ajay Rs.2,50,000 each. **Table Tennis**: Accolades to Priyanka Pareek for securing bronze medal in National Ranking Tournament & achieving 4th rank in All India Table Tennis ranking under 15. She is currently Rajasthan no.1 in U_18, 21 & women's category. Chhavi Singh stood 3rd in Rajasthan ranking Table Tennis Tournament in youth & women's category. Outstanding performance was exhibited by Daksh Jain & Modit Mendiratta securing 1st position in Rajasthan Ranking Tournament in U_12 & 15 respectively. **Tennis**: Ayushi Tanwar secured 1st position in Raj. State School Championship & Rajeev Gandhi Khel Abhiyan U_17 yrs. singles & doubles category. **Shooting**: Janmejay Singh secured bronze medal in SGFI National Shooting Championship held at Pune. **Volleyball**: Sanah Khoth did extremely well, represented Raj. & won silver medal in All India Volleyball Championship held at J & K. **Cricket**: Our school cricket team won the Jaipur District Cricket Tournament organized by JDCA. Jayesh Nair was selected for the State Level Cricket camp organized by RCA held at Jaipur.

Traffic Regulations: We have been informing you regularly regarding the strict implementation of the traffic regulations in the school. Any vehicle parked outside the school, whether by students or parents, may be picked up by the traffic police or high penalty may be imposed. Therefore, I request you to be careful about the parking of your vehicles while coming to school for any purpose. Please instruct your wards to make use of the facilities provided in the school campus for parking their vehicles. Please note that only those students with a **valid license** would be allowed to use the parking facility in the school campus. **Please make sure that the vehicles in which your wards commute to school are not over loaded to avoid any sort of inconvenience.**

Punctuality and regularity are the main aspects of school life that we insist upon. Children must be here well ahead of time in order to begin the morning assembly and the classes. Above all we request you to spend quality time with your wards on their regular hard work at home in order to ensure not merely success in the examinations but in all activities of the school – curricular and co-curricular.
